

LTL Photo Competition Terms and Conditions 2025

Version 1.0 dated 03/10/2025

- There is a maximum of ten (10) unique entries per person.
- Images must not exceed 45MB in size and are to be submitted in either JPEG, PNG or TIFF format.
- Photographs are to be submitted using the following naming structure: **First Name.Last Name_Category_Date the Photo Was Taken**
 - For example: **john.doe_b&w_01.01.2023.jpeg**
 - Images submitted without the proper naming structure may be rejected.
- Submissions close at midnight on the 28th of November 2025.
 - In the instance of too few entries, there may be an extension on the competition duration and cut-off date. In this case, we will notify you via our standard communication channels.
- Judges will be advised to consider each photograph's individual merits, both aesthetic and technical. They will then choose a winner from each of the five (5) categories, and one overall winner.
 - All results are at the discretion of the judges' and are to be considered as final.
- Lincoln University reserve the right to decline entries for any reason at the administrator's discretion.
- You are not allowed to take photographs of individual artworks that are still in copyright, but a general photograph of an area that includes multiple artworks is acceptable, as per the NZ Copyright Act (1994).
- Please be sure to get express permission if photographing cultural events or places of cultural significance (landmarks, houses/places of worship, community centers, etcetera).
- All images submitted for this competition are done so under a Creative Commons 0 license and can be used by Te Whare Wanaka o Aoraki, Lincoln
